Di based the document on the Council's Local Plan assessment document and identified the Queenshurst development as justification for the recommended parameters. Each zone in the plan has a density recommendation. John asked if we could estimate the number of dwellings and share within the committee only. Di asked for final comments before 3<sup>rd</sup> August.</p>		
5	<p><b>AGM minutes with Q&amp;A:</b> Need to spell Howard's name correctly. Apologies. Malcolm suggested we include a comment about the funds due to be returned to the Council. The minutes were then approved.</p>		
6	<p><b>Update on the Urban Room:</b></p> <p>Di said the council suggested the Urban Room as a pilot for the Local Plan consultation. Emma Crowe suggested there is a council asset in Fife Road that may be a possibility for an Urban Room (the next Urban Room meeting is likely to be at the beginning of September). The Kingston Council Local plan should go for approval in September with a view to wider consultation in October until the New Year. They hope to use the room. The resident group is concerned the room be resident led and may draft a Memorandum of Understanding to facilitate this. As an aside Kingston University is seeking to bring forward a module on Urban Rooms.</p>
