6	<p>Report back on the meeting with the council and architects about Murray House: The council is considering redevelopment for the site – for vulnerable residents. Disability access will be on the ground floor. Concerns were expressed including that of development height and form be in keeping with local context. The architect is Levitt Bernstein. We await proposals expected in the autumn. It was stressed that advocacy was key to the success of the project.</p>

8	<p>AOB: We have received a response from the Canbury Business Park landowner via their agent arguing against a comprehensive Masterplan and planning application for the site.
